CLAUSE 2
SCOPE OF THE MoU

VALIDITY**

This Agreement will be valid for a period of **three years**. Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of **Kerala**.

3. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION:
