InterPsych Summit: Exploring Multidimensional Perspectives of Psychology REPORT

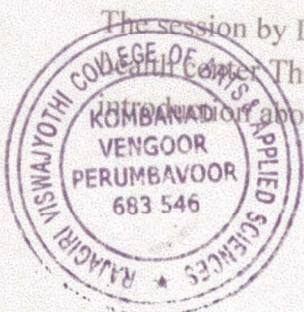

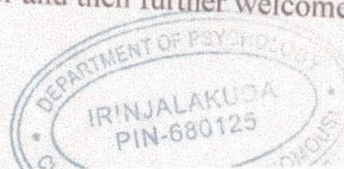

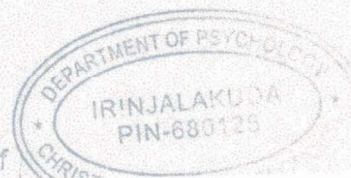
Day 2: 2 February 2024
