### PROFILE OF THE RESOURCE PERSON

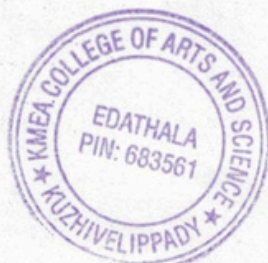
