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
Celebrations





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Stepping Stone to Success- Motivational Talk by Alumni







Screen shot of Entrepreneurship lecture by Alumni Joel Joji



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
Motivational Talk by Alumni of 2020 Batch

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
Alumni Lecture on Career Guidance

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
Interview with successful Entrepreneur

Lecture on Business Management




