

The meeting started with a silent prayer and the Principal, Prof. Dr. Devasia. M. D (Secretary) welcomed the members and briefed the agenda of the meeting. The Provincial Rev. Fr. Benny Nalkara CMI (Chairman), presided over the meeting and addressed the members. The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved.

The following were the directives of the meeting

- The Principal emphasized the importance of submitting the Self-Study Report (SSR) to NAAC by the August. All Criteria Heads were requested to compile and submit the necessary data to the IQAC for the data verification. The IQAC Co-ordinator was asked to prepare a timeline that will be shared to the Criteria Heads to ensure compliance.
- 2. It was decided that the Academic Quality Report (AQR) for the previous academic year needs to be finalized and submitted by June and also that the Academic and Administrative Audit be conducted.
- Rev. Fr. Dipin Karingen CMI proposed the construction of the "Wisdom Path" an extension of the college Library that would provide a serene reading environment for students
- Rev. Fr. Dipin Karingen CMI proposed refurbishing the library to enhance study spaces and introduce digital resources. The proposal includes new seating arrangements, lighting improvements, and an expansion of the elibrary.
- 5. A proposal to build a new psychology lab for students to meet the practical requirements of the subject was discussed.
- 6. It was decided to appoint a Physical Education faculty member who is skilled in multiple sports to boost student participation in university-level sports events. The Principal highlighted the need for a faculty member with experience in athletics, team sports, and event management.
- The Principal requested that all department heads to review the current faculty shortfall and submit their requirements for new appointments. Departments
  with high demand, such as BCA and B.Sc. Psychology were prioritized.



- 8. Given the increasing demand for BCA, it was agreed to start additional batches. The Head of the Department of Computer Applications was asked to review lab availability and faculty capacity for the additional sections.
- 9. Mr. Solymon V.L presented the placement report. The E-Governance report was also reviewed, with key improvements in digital infrastructure noted. It was proposed that the Library Audit, and IT Audit be conducted in April.
- 10. It was proposed that the college pursue a Green Campus Certificate to promote sustainability initiatives. It was decided to explore the requirements for certification and implement necessary measures.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30pm.
