Rajagiri Viswajyothi College of Arts & Applied Sciences started in the year 2013. The college started functioning in August 2014 in the building of Viswajyothi CMI Public School, Angamaly. The classes started functioning in the new building on 22nd July 2015. It has been six years since the inception of our institution. The academic year started on 6th June 2019. The year 2019-20 brought many challenges, opportunities for learning and growth, thoughtful decisions and ultimate success.

This report presents a detailed overview of the diverse activities, initiatives, and achievements from the 2019-20 academic year. These endeavors exemplify the institution's unwavering dedication to educational excellence, holistic development, and innovation.

The academic year was adeptly led by Rev. Fr. Dipin Karengen CMI, Associate Director, and Dr. Joy P. Joseph, Principal. Infrastructure

During the 2019-20 academic year, Rajagiri Viswajyothi College of Arts and Applied Sciences (RVCAS) undertook several key infrastructure developments to enhance the campus experience for students and promote sustainability:

- Ladies Hostel: A newly constructed Ladies Hostel was introduced to provide safe, comfortable, and convenient accommodation for female students.
