This report presents a detailed overview of the various activities, initiatives, and achievements from the academic year 2021-2022. These endeavors reflect the institution's unwavering dedication to educational excellence, holistic development, and innovation.

The academic year began on June 1, 2021. Despite the challenges posed by the pandemic, the institution successfully navigated its journey through both online and offline modes. The year started with two days dedicated to academic planning and the preparation of the academic calendar.

On November 1, 2021, Rajagiri Viswajyothi welcomed its first-year students (2021 admissions) with a College Opening Day celebration, coinciding with Kerala Piravi Day. The event featured various programs performed by and for the first-year students. Offline classes for the 2020 admissions began on November 8, following the completion of their first-semester examinations. Meanwhile, students from the 2018 admissions resumed offline classes on December 2, after finishing their fourth-semester university examinations.

Rajagiri Viswajyothi was privileged to host numerous programs and inter-collegiate festivals in both formats. Until November 2021, the college campus was only active during university examination periods. However, faculty members remained engaged throughout for online classes, and the college office operated fully, except during government-mandated lockdowns.

Academic Activities

The academic year 2021-22 commenced on June, 2021, with the initiation of classes for the court of the same ster 5 and Semester 3 batches. This year, Rajagiri Viswajyothi College of Arts and Applied

Sciences is proud to welcome a total of 271 students. Among this number, we have 57 first-year students who have enrolled in a variety of undergraduate programs, marking an exciting new chapter in their academic journeys. This diverse cohort not only enriches our campus community but also reflects the college's commitment to providing quality education and fostering a vibrant learning environment for all students.
