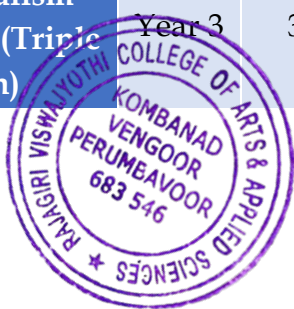

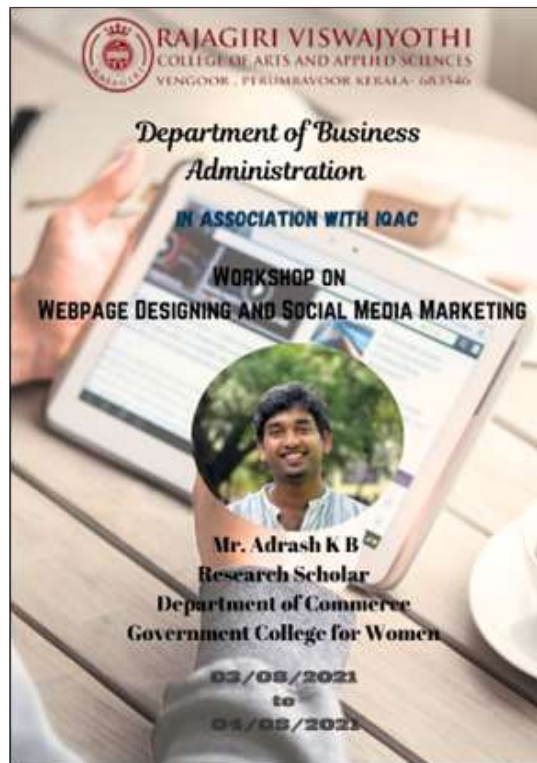


QUALITY INITIATIVES OF IQAC

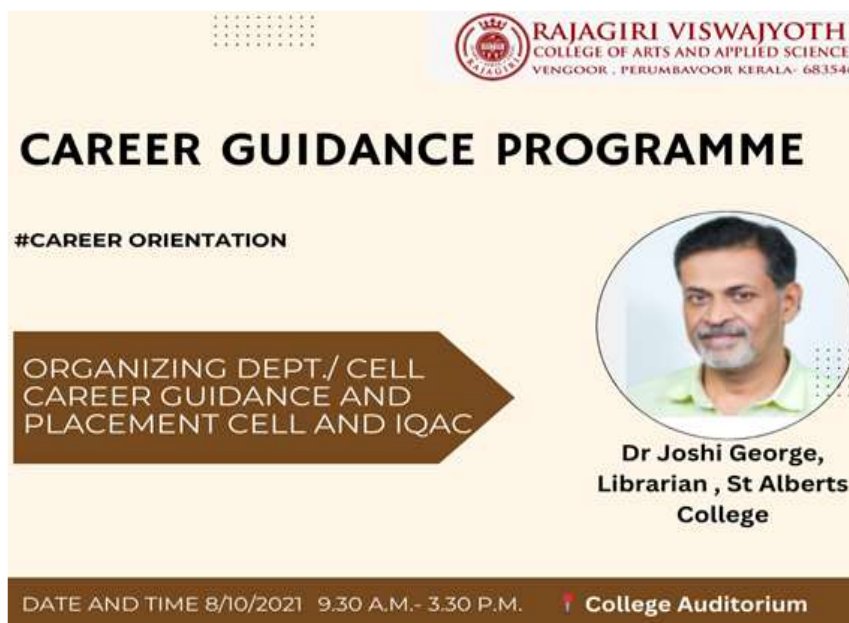
Poster of the Workshop on

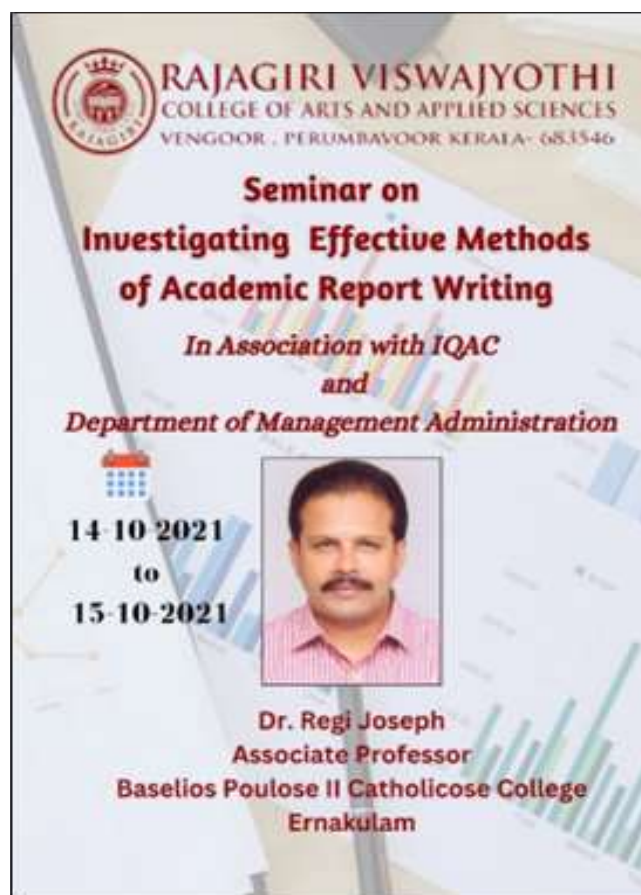
Poster of the Orientation Session on
