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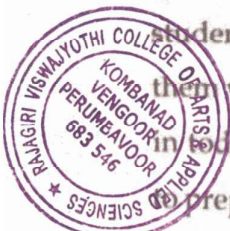
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### Activity Report on Seminar on Nurturing Soft Skills to Face Professional Challenges
